CYT Project moves into its second strand



The Communities and Youth Together Project funded by the [International Fund for Ireland](#) under their Peace Impact Programme and managed by [The Community Foundations For Northern Ireland](#) is facilitated by lead partner [Springboard Opportunities](#) and their community partner Carrick Hill Residents Association.

CYT is a 12 month programme aimed at engaging 12-17 yr olds and community leaders in the Carrick Hill and Ravenhill areas of Belfast.

Since its inception the programme has engaged over 40 young people in single identity and cross community activities, diversity education, personal and social education and OCNNI qualifications.

Now moving into its second strand 21 of the young people involved will explore what it takes to become young leaders whilst working towards their OCNNI Level 2 qualification in Peer Mentoring.

The third strand of the project, which is due to take place in March, will see 20 community leaders take part in professional development training over a three day residential.
